PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared DOLCHARRAN, DILON (6517) who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 30 day of September, 2023, in Lake County, Florida, the defendant did:


Commit the unlawful offenses of Weapon- Possess Firearm/ Ammo by Convicted Felon F.S.S.790.23(1A), Weapon- Possess Weapon/ Firearm on School Campus F.S.S.790.115(2), Weapon- Careless Exhibit Weapon/ Firearm on School Campus F.S.S.790.115(1) and Resisting- Obstructing W/Out Violence F.S.S.843.02 in that:


On Saturday, September 30, 2023, at approximately 1846 hours, officers responded to local school campus, located in Leesburg, Florida (Leesburg High School) regarding a weapon complaint. Dispatch advised that multiple callers were stating a black male wearing a multi-color shirt had a firearm on the campus, threatening subjects. Dispatch also reported the caller stated the black male was attempting to leave the campus in a gray Dodge pickup truck. Upon officer's arrival, witnesses pointed out the vehicle, a gray Dodge pickup truck bearing Florida registration number IX45HR. Officers conducted a "felony" traffic stop on the vehicle in the back parking lot of the high school.

A black female was driving the vehicle at the time of the traffic stop while he was seated in the front passenger seat. She exited the driver's seat and followed commands from officers. She immediately told officers that he husband was in the passenger seat and he did have a gun in the vehicle. The male, later identified as Quan Isom, to be referred to as the defendant, was instructed to exit the vehicle. Officers gave the defendant clear verbal commands to exit the vehicle and walk back towards their vehicle; The defendant argued with officers and scene and threatened to kill the K9 that was on scene. He eventually was standing at the front of Cpl Lamoreaux's vehicle. He was given several commands to get on the ground in order for officers to safely detain him while still monitoring the vehicle that had not been cleared yet. He refused to comply and was eventually escorted to the ground and detained. Due to his lack of cooperation, officers had to contact him in front of the vehicles instead behind safe cover, so he was quickly pulled behind cover and held secure at that point.

The defendant's wife stated they were from the Orlando area and were at the high school for the youth football game in which their juvenile son was participating. The defendant's wife stated the defendant was arguing with parent's from the Leesburg youth team about their children. One of the parents from Leesburg made a remark about their son being better than his and it upset the defendant. The defendant went to the truck and collected the firearm from inside the vehicle. The defendant's wife indicated that their truck was very close by the exit and the other spectators saw him retrieve the firearm and stick it in his waistband. The other parents fled the area due to the firearm. The defendant carelessly and openly displayed the firearm during the school-sanctioned event of homecoming and the pop Warner football game, which were simultaneously going on during this incident. The defendant's wife rushed to him and urged him to calm down and get in the truck. They tried to leave at that point and were stopped by law enforcement before exiting the lot.

PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT:

Before Me, the undersigned authority personally appeared DOLCHARRAN, DILON (6517) who being duly sworn, alleges, on information and belief, that on the 30 day of September, 2023, in Lake County, Florida, the defendant did:

The defendant's wife said he hid the firearm in its original location, back under the driver seat as they tried to leave. The defendant's wife stated the defendant was intoxicated, which was why she was driving the vehicle at the time of the traffic stop.


While officers interviewed the wife, other officers cleared the vehicle to confirm no other passengers were inside. Immediately upon approaching the vehicle, two beer bottles were observed in the center console, still with condensation on the bottles. Another bottle of whiskey was located under the seat as well. A black EAA .357 cal revolver bearing serial number 1737488 with four rounds of .38 special ammunition in the cylinder, was located under the driver's seat. The condition of the firearm was ready to fire a round due to the location of the rounds in the cylinder. A criminal history check showed the defendant had eleven prior felony convictions and should not be in the possession of a firearm.

The defendant was placed into custody and informed of his charges. The defendant was transported to the Leesburg Police Department for booking paperwork, where the defendant requested emergency medical services. The defendant was taken to UF Health Leesburg to be medically cleared and was later taken to the Lake County Jail.

The defendant committed the offenses of Weapon- Possess Weapon/ Firearm on School Campus F.S.S.790.115(2) by being in possession of the firearm while on the campus of Leesburg High School, Weapon- Careless Exhibit Weapon/ Firearm on School Campus F.S.S.790.115(1) by being on the school campus and placing the firearm on his waist, Weapon- Possess Firearm/ Ammo by Convicted Felon F.S.S.790.23(1A) by being in possession of the firearm while having eleven previous felony convictions and Resisting- Obstructing W/Out Violence F.S.S.843.02 by refusing to follow officers' lawful verbal commands during the felony traffic stop.
